MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Camp Navajo's 2022 Woodcutting and Firewood Program

1. References:

- a. AR 405-90, Disposal of Real Estate
- b. DAIM-EDT, 9 JUN 2004, subject: Army Guidance for Timber Sales

2. This memorandum acknowledges Camp Navajo Garrison Commander, per AR 405-90, the authority to conduct sales for timber with estimated value not to exceed \$5,000 per transaction, and \$30,000 annually. This includes firewood per DAIM EDT, 9 JUN 2004.

3. Camp Navajo's woodcutting season is 15 May -16 Oct 22. Wood is for private use only; no commercial resale is authorized. The Garrison Commander reserves the right to suspend or close woodcutting at any time. Woodcutting is prohibited if the fire danger is Very High, Extreme, or Red Flag.

4. Authorized participants are Military, Veterans, and current AZDEMA employees. Signed "Waiver of Liability" is required. All participants must receive "All Hazards UXO" safety briefing before woodcutting can begin. Woodcutting is at your own risk.

5. All applicants apply and receive permits through the Camp Navajo, Environmental Office. All Woodcutters must check in/out with CN Security daily. All proceeds collected through Pay.gov and deposited in the Conservation Reimbursable Program and associated Forestry Reimbursable Account.

6. Requests for support to civilian agencies, non-governmental organizations and charities for fuel/firewood begin at the DEMA Public Affairs Office or the Joint Task Force for vetting and approval. Coordinating efforts upon approval are with POC named in paragraph 7 and AZTC Operations.
