



The Adjutant General



- 1636 Founding of the National Guard, when the Massachusetts Bay Colony organized its first three militia regiments
- 1865 Arizona stands up the First Arizona Volunteer Infantry Regiment
- National Guard in Arizona Constitution, Article 16
- 1942 Creation of the Arizona Civilian Defense Board and Council, forerunner to AZ Division of Emergency Management (1971)
- 1972 Arizona Department of Emergency and Military Affairs (DEMA) established through integration of Department of Military Affairs (Arizona National Guard) and Division of Emergency Management















- » Mission: Provide Military and Emergency Management Capabilities to Citizens of Arizona and the Nation.
- » Vision: The nation's premier agency capable of responding to local, state and federal missions.






Arizona National Guard Locations


