<u>Motion #7:</u> A motion was made by Mr. Allen Clark to allocate \$75,000.00 from the Governor's Emergency Fund to the August 2021 Coconino Flooding event (SD2206) on May 22, 2023. Motion was **seconded** by Ms. Tonia Tunnell. (Motion passed unanimously)
