**SUMMARY OF DUTIES:** This position is located with the 197<sup>th</sup> ARS at the 161 ARW in Phoenix, Arizona. Aircraft may include KC-135R, KC-135T, and KC-46. Configurations vary between Boom, Drogue, and MPRS refueling. This is an Air National Guard (ANG) Dual Status Technician position requiring military membership, compatible military skill assignment, and classification. The primary purpose of this position is to provide ground and flight training instruction for developing, upgrading, and evaluating the skills of aerial refueling aircrew members; as the sole enlisted aircrew member performs aerial refueling technician duties on assigned missions; and assists the pilot in the operation of the aircraft by performing duties associated with loadmaster, flight engineer and navigator positions.

**HOW APPLICANTS WILL BE ASSESSED:** If your resume does not include a narrative description of how you meet the SPECIALIZED experiences and OTHER requirements, you may lose consideration for this position.

**SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE:** Must have at least 24 months of experience which has provided a general knowledge of aircraft fuel, electrical, and hydraulic systems and components. Experience in providing ground and flight training to develop and upgrade the skills of assigned Air National Guard and Active Duty aircrew members, administering flight evaluations of aircrew members and instructors, and evaluating the effectiveness of the aircrew training program for the squadron commander. Experience in instructing students on inflight duties and administers all receiver category certifications. Experience in conducting classroom instruction to individual or groups of Inflight Refueling Technicians and Pilots for initial, upgrade, recurring continuation training, and Mission Ready Combat Training (MCT). Experience in instructing personnel on the development and certifying of cargo load plans considering weight, quantity, configuration, floor capacity, compartment restrictions, and proper location within the aircraft to achieve the optimum center of gravity for ground and flight operations. Experience in instructing new personnel in preparation for receiver aircraft category qualification / certifications and OPLAN 8010 Certification.

### **CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT & NOTES:**

- Must attain and maintain mission-ready status at the appropriate crew qualification level in the unit's assigned aircraft. Periodically, as prescribed by regulations, must take and pass written and in-flight standardization evaluation examinations to include random no notice evaluations.

- The incumbent is exposed to physiological hazards of flight plus physical and psychological demands of routine lengthy missions (up to 24 hours duration), must work in confined, hazardous noise areas, is subject to inclement weather during ground operations and dangerous environmental conditions during flight, and may operate in austere location.
- May be required to travel in military and commercial aircraft to perform temporary duty assignments.
- Must be instructor qualified, maintaining proficiency in the Principles of Instruction.
- May be required to maintain flight examiner qualification. Periodically, as prescribed by regulations, must take and pass written and in-flight standardization/ evaluation examinations to include random no-notice evaluations.
- Required to maintain proficiency in the use of firearms. As prescribed by regulation, may be required to carry and use a concealed weapon while performing aircrew related duties.
- Employee must maintain a Secret/Top Secret-SCI clearance.

**MILITARY TECHNICIAN COMPATIBILITY:** Prior to placement in this position, the selected applicant must be assigned to an appropriate military position and must meet the definition of a dual status technician in accordance with 32 USC 709(b) & CNGBI 303.
