<u>Motion #3:</u> A motion was made by Mr. Paul Brierley to allocate \$400,000.00 from the Governor's Emergency Fund to the July 2021 Pinal County Flooding event (SD2204) on June 07, 2024. Motion was **seconded** by Ms. Elizabeth Alvarado-Thorson. (Motion passed unanimously)

<u>Motion #4:</u> A motion was made by Ms. Tonia Tunnell to allocate \$500,000.00 from the Governor's Emergency Fund to the July 2021 Northern Monsoonal Flooding event (SD2202) on June 07, 2024. Motion was **seconded** by Ms. Karen Peters. (Motion passed unanimously)

<u>Motion #5:</u> A motion was made by Ms. Vanessa Hickman to allocate \$200,000.00 from the Governor's Emergency Fund to the August 2021 Coconino Flooding event (SD2206) on June 07, 2024. Motion was **seconded** by Mr. Tom Neve. (**Motion passed unanimously**)

<u>Motion #6:</u> A motion was made by Ms. Tonia Tunnell to allocate \$50,000.00 from the Governor's Emergency Fund to the Tunnel Fire event (SD2210) on June 07, 2024. Motion was **seconded** by Ms. Sonya Herrera. (Motion passed unanimously)

<u>Motion #7:</u> A motion was made by Ms. Vanessa Hickman to allocate \$150,000.00 from the Governor's Emergency Fund to the Coconino Floods event (SD2303) on June 07, 2024. Motion was **seconded** by Mr. Gabriel Lavine. (**Motion passed unanimously**)

<u>Motion #8:</u> A motion was made by Mr. Paul Brierley to allocate \$250,000.00 from the Governor's Emergency Fund to the 2022 Arizona City Flooding event (SD2309) on June 07, 2024. Motion was **seconded** by Mr. Tom Neve. (**Motion passed unanimously**)

<u>Motion #9:</u> A motion was made by Ms. Sonya Herrera to allocate up to \$550,000.00 from the Governor's Emergency Fund to the 2022 July Pinal Flooding event (SD2304) on June 30, 2024. Motion was **seconded** by Ms. Tonia Tunnell. (**Motion passed unanimously**)

<u>Motion #10:</u> A motion was made by Mr. Tom Neve to allocate up to \$900,000.00 from the Governor's Emergency Fund to the Rioting – Imposition of Curfew event (SD2005) on June 30, 2024. Motion was **seconded** by Ms. Elizabeth Alvarado-Thorson. (**Motion passed unanimously**)
