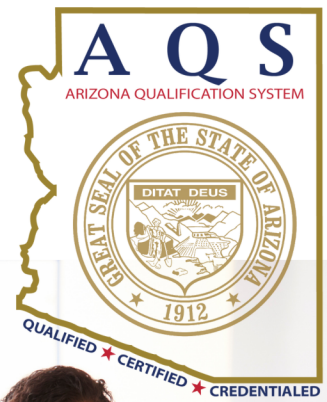


Arizona Qualification System

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The AQS is a voluntary system designed to enhance statewide personnel deployment efficiency. It creates a consistent framework aligned with national standards for qualified personnel readiness. The AQS promotes all-hazards training and credentialing while providing local agencies with resources to manage Emergency Operations Centers (EOC) and Incident Command Organizations effectively, in line with National Incident Management System (NIMS) standards.

Benefits to User Organizations:

- ✓ Qualify, Certify, and Credential personnel to operate in an EOC or ICS organization.
- ✓ Meet the Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) program requirements.
- ✓ Access additional qualified, certified and credentialed personnel to assist during events, emergencies, and disasters.

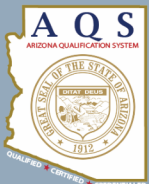
