I further agree to hold such entities harmless and release them from any and all liability including any loss or damage and any claim or demand therefore on account of injury to person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned arising out of or related to participation in hunting on Camp Navajo.

This waiver extends to any and all acts of negligence of the entities, and their employees and is intended to be as broad and inclusive a release as is permitted by Arizona State law but is not intended to relieve any of the entities from responsibilities for willful or intentional misconduct or acts of gross criminal negligence. The undersigned acknowledges that he/she has had the opportunity to have this waiver reviewed by the legal counsel of his/her choosing and agrees to follow all rules, regulations, and laws described in the Camp Navajo Hunting SOP – Pamphlet.
