- **ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS IF GOING INTO AMMUNITION STORAGE AREA**

If you will be visiting the Ammunition Storage area at Camp Navajo you will need a Security Clearance or you will need to be escorted by someone with a security clearance or a Camp Navajo employee. Additionally, if you require your cell phone while in the Ammunition Storage area, you will also need a cell phone permit on file. If you are going to be taking pictures in the Ammunition Storage area you will also need to have a camera permit on file.

- **Security Requirement Information**

Fill out the attached form 19b and fax or mail to your Camp Navajo point of contact for processing. Camp Navajo, P. O. Box 16123, Bellemont, AZ 86015 Attn: Your Point of Contact.

You will be required to give your full name, social security number and date of birth.

The security clearance information will be verified by the appropriate security Manager for clearance.
