

Battle Drills Order of Operations: Red Flag Warning Issued

1. **Fire Weather:** CNFD determines Fire Weather Danger Level from NOAA Website

RED FLAG WARNING IS ISSUED BY NOAA

2. **Notification of Red Flag Condition** Fire Weather Danger Level:

- (1) The CNFD notifies Range Control Officer/NCOIC via phone (3155)/email
- (2) The CNFD notifies the Garrison Operations Sergeant via phone (928) 607-5749/email
- (3) The CNFD notifies the Campsite host via phone (928) 699-8866 or in person
 - a. The Garrison Operations Sergeant notifies the Garrison Commander/Security
 - b. The Range Control Officer/NCOIC notifies all units

4a. **Request to Begin/Resume Training:**

- (1) The Range Control Officer/NCOIC will authorize units to resume/begin training
- (2) The Range Control Officer/NCOIC will notify specific units regarding any training restrictions

Authorized:

No Live Fire or other spark producing activities without authorization from The Garrison Commander

Ball Ammo 5.56 or Below. Unit must have communications on site to contact CNFD / Range Control as needed

Battle Drills Order of Operations: Change in Fire Weather to *EXTREME*

1. Fire Weather:

CNFD determines Fire Weather Danger Level from NOAA Website

Fire Weather changes to *EXTREME*

2. Notification of *EXTREME* Fire Weather Danger Level:

- (1) The CNFD notifies Range Control Officer/NCOIC via phone (3155)/email
- (2) The CNFD notifies the Garrison Operations Sergeant via phone (928) 607-5749/email
 - a. The Garrison Operations Sergeant notifies the Garrison Commander/Security
 - b. The Range Control Officer/NCOIC notifies all units
 - c. The CNFD notifies the Campsite host via phone (928) 699-8866 or in person

1. Fire Weather:

CNFD determines Fire Weather Danger Level from NOAA Website

Fire Weather changes to VERY HIGH

2. Notification of VERY HIGH Fire Weather Danger Level:

- (1) The CNFD notifies Range Control Officer/NCOIC via phone (3155)/email
- (2) The CNFD notifies the Garrison Operations Sergeant via phone (928) 607-5749/email
 - a. The Garrison Operations Sergeant notifies the Garrison Commander/Security
 - b. The Range Control Officer/NCOIC notifies all units
 - c. The CNFD notifies the Campsite host via phone (928) 699-8866 or in person

Battle Drills Order of Operations: *Change in Fire Weather to HIGH*

1. Fire Weather:

CNFD determines Fire Weather Danger Level from NOAA Website

Fire Weather changes to HIGH

2. Notification of HIGH Fire Weather Danger Level:

- (1) The CNFD notifies the Range Control Officer/NCOIC via phone (3155)/email
- (2) The CNFD notifies the Garrison Operations Sergeant via phone (928) 607-5749/email
 - a. The Garrison Operations Sergeant notifies the Garrison Commander
 - b. The Range Control Officer/NCOIC notifies all units

4. Request to Begin/Resume Training:

- (1) The Garrison Operations Commander will authorize units to resume/begin training
- (2) The Garrison Operations Sergeant will notify the Range Control Officer/NCOIC
- (3) The Range Control Officer/NCOIC will notify specific Units regarding any training restrictions

Battle Drills Order of Operations: *Fire Weather: Moderate and Low*

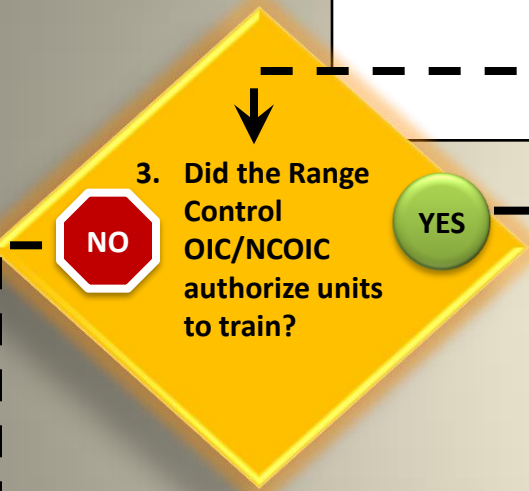
LOW

1. Fire Weather:
CNFD determines Fire Weather Danger Level from NOAA Website

Fire Weather changes to MODERATE or LOW

2. Notification of MODERATE or LOW Fire Weather Danger Level:
(1) The CNFD notifies the Range Control Officer/NCOIC via phone (3155)/email
(2) The CNFD notifies the Garrison Operations Sergeant via phone (928) 607-5749/email
 a. The Garrison Operations Sergeant notifies the Garrison Commander
 b. The Range Control Officer/NCOIC notifies all units

(1) The Range Control Officer/NCOIC will authorize units to resume/begin training
(2) The Range Control Officer/NCOIC will notify specific Units regarding any training restrictions



MODERATE Authorized:
 Ball, Artillery, Tracer, Sub-caliber ammo
 Smoke, CS, Simulators, Demo, and Grenades in low to no vegetation
 Smoking in designated smoking area with authorized heat and flame permit only
 Wood and Charcoal fires in developed recreation sites and with an authorized heat and flame permit
 Wood Cutting when authorized

MODERATE Not authorized:
 White phosphorus
 Air-borne pyrotechnics

LOW Authorized:
 Ball, Tracer, Sub-caliber ammo
 Smoke, CS, Simulators, WP, Demo, and Grenades in low to no vegetation
 Smoking in designated smoking area with authorized heat and flame permit only
 Wood and Charcoal fires in developed recreation sites and with an authorized heat and flame permit
 Wood cutting when authorized

LOW Not authorized:
 Air-borne pyrotechnics
