Subject: Issuance of FEMA Interim Policy for Eligible Work, and HHS "School Mask Program" Fact Sheet

FEMA and Health and Human Services (HHS) have issued the attached documents this week. **Please review these policies as they may have a significant impact on potential reimbursement for your organization.**

The FEMA interim policy "Work Eligible for Public Assistance" (FP 104-009-19) is a policy for costs incurred after September 15, 2020. It clarifies existing policy as well as sets policy for COVID19 eligible activities/costs. Section C "Work Eligibility" details what will be eligible after September 15th.

We continue to coordinate with FEMA in how this interim policy will be applied for costs incurred between January 20, 2020 and September 14, 2020. Projects submitted or being submitted for this time period will be assessed on a case by case basis by FEMA for costs/activities not described in the interim policy. DEMA will support all Applicant submissions for cost incurred.

As additional guidance is received from FEMA, we will notify your designated point(s) of contact through our Project Specialist assigned to your organization.
