

Cyber Awareness Tips



Use passphrases instead of passwords.

- ⊕ Minimum 8 characters (15 or more is best)
- ⊕ Example (do not use): !!LoveMyFamilyOf4!
- ⊕ Use distinct passphrases for every system (i.e., banking, work, social, etc.)

Use caution when using



the web, when opening email and attachments. Ensure **https** is used for all web logins.



Do not share your passwords with **anyone**.



Information shared on social media and other electronic communications can be obtained forever.



Ensure your devices are patched/updated regularly.



Lock your workstation when you leave.
