LOCATION OF POSITION:

Peace Vanguard (USAFTD), MARANA (25 Miles NW of Tucson), ARIZONA

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is in the Fulltime National Guard Duty Operational Support (FTNGD-OS) position and is open to current members of the Arizona Army National Guard in the grades of SSG/E6-E7/SFC. In order to be considered for this position, applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined in this announcement.

NOTE: Applicants must be 15Y MOSQ (Unit/Battalion Maintenance Experience).

NOTE: Members must meet the listed Active Federal Service (AFS) requirements outlined in NGB-ARH Policy Memorandum #09-021, #09-014 and #13-020 to apply.

NOTE: Applicant that has completed 4 or more years of Active Service (AS) should not apply unless they have had a 31 day break in service per the guidelines above.

NOTE: Selection for this position requires declaration of Arizona state residency at the time of in-processing, and maintaining that residency while in FTNGD-OS status under Title 32, USC.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: IAW NGB-ARH Policy Memorandum 09-021, 09-014 and 13-020 the documents listed **WILL** be submitted "AS A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to the candidate, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

The individual(s) must be a member of the Arizona (ARMY) National Guard and qualify for and be placed in the following compatible MOS/AOC: 15Y

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must meet the medical fitness standards for retention per AR 40-501, chapter 3.
2. Soldiers must meet the physical requirements of AR 600-9.
3. Must be MOS qualified to be eligible this FTNGD-OS position.

4. ARNG applicants must be able to serve at least 3 years in FTNGD-OS status prior to completing 18 years of Active Service or mandatory removal from active service based on age or service (without any extensions) under any provision of law or regulation as prescribed by current directives.
5. Acceptance of a position at Peace Vanguard **TERMINATES** entitlements to be Selected Reserve Incentive Program (SRIP), as it is in a TDA unit JFHQ.
6. Permanent Change of Station (PCS expenses may be authorized for this position. Authorization of payment of PCS expenses will be granted only after a determination is made that PCS is in the best interest of the Peace Vanguard and upon availability of funds from Program Manager.
7. Must not be flagged in SIDPERS for weight, APFT, security violations or pending any adverse actions
8. Soldiers grade must be commensurate with the grade of the vacancy; voluntary demotions will not be authorized
9. SM must have less than 1095days of concurrent FTNGD-OS, and 6 years of combined status in this functional duty status.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED FOR SUCCESSFUL PERFORMANCE IN THIS POSITION OR THE MOS PREREQUISITES:

3. **Must have a current Favorable ENTNAC, and the ability to obtain an interim clearance, with follow-on SECRET classification at final determination**

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION: The successful candidate will work closely with contract personnel and Airmen from the Republic of Singapore Air Force (RSAF) providing mission sustainment support. This will involve working outside MOS the majority of the time. Field experience on AH-64D aircraft Armament systems is required as you will provide technical guidance from time to time. Selectee must be able to aid RSAF with diagnosing and repairing malfunctions on AH-64D aircraft systems utilizing the Interactive Electronic Technical Manual (IETM), directives, aviation safety action messages, and airworthiness releases. Selectee must possess training and experience in FARP operations, including set up, safety certifications and clearing weapons system malfunctions. Selectee will serve as NCOIC for ground crew cross country movements in support of aircraft ferry flights to TDY locations. Selectee may be tasked with physically working such programs such as HAZMAT, TMDE, POL, Army Oil Analysis Program (AOAP), ammunition/explosives. Will be required to perform Ground Support Equipment (GSE) maintenance and training. Properly classifies and stores SDS and inspects inventories of petroleum products for use on aircraft maintenance. Additionally, selectee may be tasked as a Government purchase card holder and required to provide logistical support such as purchasing supplies and facilitating TDY mission needs. Selectee should have an understanding of U.S. Government Unit/IMPAC card holder and GFEBS operations process and functionality. Selectee manages parts and facility requirements to repair aircraft and associated equipment for the Singapore Air Force. Selectee will perform many hands on, physical tasks to maintain, repair, support and peripheral equipment. Selectee assists with the planning of aircraft maintenance areas, and facilitates by the book aircraft repair and technical inspection techniques according to directives, technical manuals, SOP and operational policies for TDY mission and aircraft recovery. Maintains supply economy and discipline through multiple TDY mission operations annually, and assists with the unit's technical training program. Prepares evaluations, special reports and records pertaining to aircraft maintenance repair and related activities. Selectee may be placed in charge of drivers training program. Must be able to go TDY a minimum of four times a year depending on current year OPTEMPO. May be required to perform night shift mission to support operational requirements.

ADDITIONAL EXPERIENCE PREFERRED:

Previous FARP Pad Chief experienced. Have knowledge of unit and battalion aviation maintenance operations; understanding U.S. Government card holder process and GFEBS; Fiscal Law; NDI background; GSE management; HAZMAT certification; mission safety background; drivers training background and OSHA standards of operation; key lock custodian background, Army Basic Instructor Course qualified.
