AREAS OF CONSIDERATION

THE JOINT COUNTER NARCO-TERRORISM TASK FORCE (JCNTF) IS AN EQUAL OPPORTUNITY EMPLOYER. SELECTION FOR THIS POSITION WILL BE BASED ON MERIT, FITNESS, CAPABILITY, AND POTENTIAL TO ENSURE FAIR TREATMENT OF ALL GUARDMEMBERS.

GENERAL INFORMATION

This position is title 32, Full Time National Guard Duty-Counterdrug funded. Program funds are provided on a fiscal year to fiscal year basis. Task force members are required to uphold the highest standards of conduct and personal appearance. Outside employment, associations, on-and off-duty conduct/activities must be consistent with federal directives on ethics (DoD 5500.7-R) and with state and federal conflict of interest policies. Members of the JCNTF must meet service height and weight requirements (or body fat standards) and must not have a suspension of favorable actions. All personnel on the JCNTF are required to continue attendance at IDT/IAD and Annual Training. Preference may be given to Guard members whose unit of assignment is within a reasonable commuting distance of the JCNTF duty location for this position, which is Silver Bell Army Heliport, Marana, Arizona. A favorable Entrance Agency Check or National Agency Check (ENTNAC/NAC) in the past fifteen years is required. All new hires are subject to the conditions of a one-year probation policy.

Additional Requirements Are:

*Initial medical procurement standards for active duty are more demanding than retention standards under which National Guard members serve. A new medical examination or a medical review by the state surgeon is required prior to issuance of initial orders. Pregnancy disqualifies a Guard member's initial entry on to ADSW tours.

*Urinalysis testing upon entry on active duty, and periodic testing while on active duty. These requirements are in addition to testing by units of assignment during IDT/IAD under the National Guard Substance Abuse Program.

*Applicants meeting National Guard standards and designated for duty with law enforcement agencies (LEAs) may be subject to further screening by the LEA. This screening will be conducted within the first 30 days of entry on the JCNTF. LEAs may require a security clearance or criminal records check or other background inquiry; all such inquiries are made by the LEAs in accordance with their own legal authority. Rejection by a LEA may result in termination from the JCNTF program.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION

Completed applications should be turned into the JCNTF Personnel Office, Bldg. L4100, Silverbell Army Heliport, Pinal Airpark Road, Marana, AZ 85653 prior to the closing date posted on the announcement. The following item(s) are required to apply for a position with the JCNTF:

- Completed application with Commanders Recommendation form.
- Copy of military service point credit history.
- Copy of DA Form 759 showing current flight hours.

Applications are destroyed upon completion of the selection process. Personnel not selected have five days from their notification date to appeal the selection process to the selecting official.

Additional documentation may be submitted and considered; DA Form 2-1, evaluation reports or a resume which will be given to the selecting official.

SPECIAL EXPERTISE REQUIREMENTS

Soldier must be UH-72A qualified enlisted crew member (15T), and have been rated Readiness Level (RL) 1 Day, Night, NVG in the last 180 days with experience in a Security and Support Helicopter Company. Applicant should have a minimum of 200 hours of crew chief time with a minimum of 50 hours of NVD time. Applicant must possess a Federal Aviation Administration Airframe and Power Plant maintenance certificate and completed the Eurocopter/Airbus Maintainer Course. Applicant should possess strong oral and written communication skills, be able to formally present ideas to an audience and be able to work well with small group dynamics.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Soldier works under the general supervision of the Officer-in-Charge of the Counterdrug Army aviation mission of the JCNTF. Incumbent is expected to use initiative and good judgment to fulfill the responsibilities of this position which require both enlisted crew member duties and other duties assigned. Review of work is made by observation of people skills, crew member skills, attainment of goals and objectives, and overall contribution and success of the Counterdrug Aviation Team and the incumbent's M-day unit of assignment. This position requires exceptional aviation and people skills in a variety of demanding work environments in support of law enforcement/counter narco- terrorism efforts. This position requires a significant percentage of night duty and weekend duty as "normal duty hours". This position requires a significant amount of TDY around the state as operations dictate.
