 5. Must be able to possess a SECRET clearance
 6. NGB Form 23, NGB Form 22b (RPAS Statement), retirement record (National Guard Only).
 7. last 3 NCOER's
 8. Females-Negative pregnancy test

Prepare and maintain clothing and OCIE records for a rear detachment soldiers. Execute required documentation for turn-in of un-serviceable or excess equipment. Maintains hand receipts along with component inventories. Performs security checks in accordance with AR 190-11. Works closely with rear detachment commanders to ensure all monthly inventories are completed.
