Open to members of the Active Army and Army National Guard within the grades of E5 and E6. Previous applicants still interested in the position can reapply for this position. NOTE: Applicants must be 92Y/92A MOSQ (Unit/Battalion/Brigade Personnel Experience). NOTE: Members must meet the listed Active Federal Service requirements outline in NGB-ARH Policy Memorandum #09-021, #09-014 and #13-020 to apply. NOTE: Applicant that has completed 4 or more years of Active Service should not apply unless they have had a 31 day break in service per the guidelines above. NOTE: Selection for this position requires declaration of Arizona state residency at the time of in-processing, and maintaining that residency while in FTNGD-OS status under Title 32, USC.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of: E5 to E6. Individual selected will receive an FTNGD-OS Tour with the Arizona Army and/or Air National Guard. In order to be considered for this position's applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement.

 7. Permanent Change of Station (PCS expenses may be authorized for this position). Authorization of payment of PCS expenses will be granted only after a determination is made that PCS is in the best interest of the Peace Vanguard and upon availability of funds from the Program Manager
 8. Physical demands rating of heavy
 9. A physical profile of 222222
 10. Must have a current Favorable ENTNAC, and the ability to obtain an interim clearance, with follow-on SECRET classification at final determination
 11. A U.S. citizen
 12. ARNG applicants must be able to serve at least 3 years in FTNGD-OS status prior to completing 18 years of Active Service or mandatory removal from active service based on age or service (without any extensions) under any provision of law or regulation as prescribed by current directives

Receives, inspects, inventories, loads, unloads, segregates, stores, issues, delivers and turns in assigned equipment. Prepares supply documents. Maintains automated and manual supply systems for the accounting of organizational supplies. Issues and receives small arms. Secures and controls weapons and ammunition into secure areas; responsible for dispatch, accounting and maintenance of GSA vehicles. Coordinates supply activities with Logistics Officer and vendors. Establishes and maintains formal and informal communication with maintenance, transportation, and training activities. Performs supervisory and management duties pertaining to the requisition, issue, and management of all aspects of supply accountability. Performs site visits to training locations to establish and meet the needs of the RSAF transportation, lodging, and life sustainment requirements.
