AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of: O2 to O3. Individual selected will receive an FTNGD-OS Tour with the Arizona Army and/or Air National Guard. In order to be considered for this position's applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement.

If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position. 1. preferred O-3 (with previous successful company command) with preferably Combat, Combat Support experience

 5. must possess Government Travel Card and have the ability to travel
 6. Must have a current Army Physical Fitness Test taken within 6 months of the start date.

 8. Must not be flagged in SIDPERS for weight, APFT, security violations or pending any adverse actions
 9. Must not be within six (6) months of mandatory removal or Expiration Term of Service (ETS).

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:
This position is located within the Arizona Army National Guard, DCSOPS Training Division. The selectee will be utilized in the planning and execution of training and provide Observer Controller/Trainer (OC/T) support during training events, mobilization events, and collective training requirements to support ARNG XCTC rotations. The selectee will be placed on orders throughout Training Year 2017, with a three month initial probation period and subject to the availability of funds. The selectee will be expected to attend a two week OC/T training event that will be conducted by the Ops Group Wolf located at Camp Atterbury, IN; in addition to supporting 1-2 XCTC rotations as an OC/T. The focus for TY17 is to assist units with collective training and attend XCTC 17-01 (20 May- 09 Jun) and/or XCTC 17-03 (11 Jun- 20 Jul). The selected individual will also have to attend IDT and AT with his/her assigned unit, in addition to supporting Arizona Army National Guard units' training requirements. The selectee will receive an LOI with the pertinent information in regards to the OC/T training events, XTCT rotational support, and state training events which will include information on all travel, lodging, packing lists, training information, and any additional support requirements.

The selectee will also perform state level DTMS duties and be expected to attend the DTMS User Course and the DTMS Master Trainer Course at Ft Bliss, TX, with the intent to train BDE, BN, and unit level staff on DTMS requirements. Provide technical guidance and assistance to subordinate elements, operation sections, and other staff sections in planning, coordinating, preparing, conducting, and documenting individual and collective training. Assists the Chief, Training Division in the development and review of training directives, planning, and training assessments. Conducts and/or coordinates assistance visits in all areas of training management. Reviews training schedules, circulars, and yearly training plans to ensure they are commensurate with the Chief, Training Division's priorities and higher headquarters guidance. Other duties as assigned.
