APPOINTMENT FACTORS: OFFICER WARRANT OFFICER ENLISTED

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is in the Active Guard and Reserve Force and is open to current members of the Arizona Army National Guard in the grades of SPC/E4 through SGT/E5. Individual selected will receive an Active Duty Title 32 Tour with the Arizona Army National Guard. In order to be considered for this position, applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined on the reverse of this announcement.

NOTES:

The MOS is 12N2O with daily responsibilities as an AGR Supply NCO. Qualified 92Y applicants are preferred.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: IAW NGR 600-5, paragraph 2-4, the documents listed **WILL** be submitted "AS A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. **Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position.**

- c. Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS printout from Unit)(not AKO medical readiness).
- d. DA Form 705 (APFT), within the last 5 years (ensure that height and weight are annotated). Profiles must be attached if applicable.
- e. Body Fat Worksheet (DA Form 5500-R) if applicable.
- f. Certified copy of current ERB (from OPM or unit MACOM).
- g. Photo copies of Last 5 NCOERs.
- h. NGB Form 23, NGB Form 22b (RPAS Statement), retirement record (National Guard Only).
- i. All DD Form 214's or NGB Form 22's
- j. Memorandum to HRO to request an active service waiver for those with less than 4 years AS
- k. DD Form 369 (Oct 2011) Police Record Check

APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must meet the medical fitness standards for retention per AR 40-501, chapter 3.
2. Soldiers must meet the physical requirements of AR 600-9.
3. Must have the potential to become MOS qualified in the first 12 months or be released from AD/FTNGD.

- 4 ARNG applicants must be able to serve at least 3 years in AGR status prior to completing 18 years of Active Service or mandatory removal from active service based on age or service (without any extensions) under any provision of law or regulation as prescribed by current directives.
5. AGR soldiers will not be reassigned during the first 36 months of their initial tour except in the event of mobilization, force structure changes, or an exception to policy granted by the Recruiting and Retention Commander.
6. Must possess the grade equal to or below that authorized for the AGR duty position.
7. Acceptance of an AGR position **TERMINATES** entitlements to be Selected Reserve Incentive Program (SRIP).
8. Permanent Change of Station (PCS expenses may be authorized for this position. Authorization of payment of PCS expenses will be granted only after a determination is made that PCS is in the best interest of the Arizona Army National Guard and upon availability of funds from the National Guard Bureau.
9. Additional qualification requirements are outlined in NGR 600-5, AR 135-18 and other applicable regulations and laws governing the Active Guard/Reserve Program.
10. Must not be flagged in SIDPERS for weight, APFT, security violations or pending any adverse actions
11. Applicants who answer YES to questions 8, or 12-18 of section IV, NGB Form 34-1, or have not completed Initial entry training (IET) are ineligible to apply. to include DD214(s) that have unfavorable remarks to include; unsatisfactory Performance, Misconduct, Dropped from the Rolls (DRF) Unsuitability/Unfitness or in lieu of court-martial AR 135-18, AR 135-91 Chapter 4,26, AR 135-178 Chapter 8,3 and 635-200 Chapter 11.
12. Individuals selected for AGR tours that cannot obtain 20 years of Active Federal Service prior to reaching mandatory separation, must complete a statement of understanding acknowledging this fact. Waiver authority rests with the Human Resource Officer for non-control graded positions and with National Guard Bureau (NGB) for control Graded positions

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED FOR SUCCESSFUL PERFORMANCE IN THIS POSITION OR THE MOS PREREQUISITES: MOSC 12N20. Serves as a Horizontal Construction Sergeant with limited supervision of construction equipment and personnel activities. Soldiers are senior and become primary operators for all finishing work and complex operating situations on horizontal construction projects. Provides guidance to less experienced equipment operators on operating techniques, procedures, and operator maintenance.

b. Physical demands rating and qualifications for initial award of MOS. Horizontal construction engineer must possess the following qualifications:

- (1) Physical demands rating--Light.
- (2) A physical profile of 222221.
- (3) Red/green color discrimination.
- (4) Qualifying scores.

(a) A minimum score of 90 in aptitude area GM in Armed Services Vocational aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002.

(b) A minimum score of 90 in aptitude area GM on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002.

(5) Must possess a valid state motor vehicle operator license.

(6) Formal training (completion of MOS 12N course conducted under the auspices of the USA Engineer Center and School, or meet civilian acquired skills criteria per paragraph 9-5 (5) (b) of this pamphlet and in paragraph (7) below.

(7) ACASP qualification criteria.

Must have 2 years of experience operating each of the following pieces of equipment; crawler tractor, grader, loader, hydraulic excavator, backhoe loader, rollers, tractor trailers, and dump trucks . (a) IAW table 9-1 of this pamphlet, Initial Entry Trainee (IET) who qualifies under the ACASP will not be required to attend Advanced Individual Training (AIT) for any additional training. Upon completion of Basic Combat Training (BCT) Soldier Member will be processed IAW initial assignment instruction.

(b) Approval and validation to qualify IET for ACASP is through the USAES, Engineer Personnel Development Office (EPDO).

(c) Have a valid state motor vehicle license.

(8) Must be able to possess a SECRET clearance

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION: Directs supply personnel in establishing supply and inventory control management functions. Maintains property under the standard property book unit supply enhanced (PBUSE). Reviews daily and monthly records of issues of petroleum products and operating supplies. Provides technical assistance to equipment records and parts specialist. Assists and advises supply officer and commander. Inspects completed work for accuracy and compliance with established procedures. Coordinates supply activities. Reviews and annotates changes to unit material condition status report. Post transactions to organizational and installation property books and supporting transaction files. Determines method of obtaining relief from responsibility for lost, damaged and destroyed supply items. Other duties as assigned.
