MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

1. Acceptance of a position at Peace Vanguard TERMINATES entitlements to be Selected Reserve Incentive Program (SRIP), as it is in a TDA unit JFHQ
 2. ARNG applicants must be able to serve at least 3 years in FTNGD-OS status prior to completing 18 years of Active Service or mandatory removal from active service based on age or service (without any extensions) under any provision of law or regulation as prescribed by current directives
 3. Must be MOS qualified to be eligible for this FTNGD-OS position.
 4. Must meet the medical fitness standards for retention per AR 40-501, chapter 3
 5. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 600-9
 6. Must not be flagged in SIDPERS for weight, APFT, security violations or pending any adverse actions
 7. PCS may be authorized for this position. Authorization of payment of PCS expenses will be granted only after a determination is made that PCS is in the best interest of the Peace Vanguard program and upon availability of funds from the Program Manager

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Diagnoses and repairs malfunctions on AH-64D attack helicopter armament, electronics, avionics, and instrument/fire control systems; analyzes and corrects faults in components according to interactive electronic technical manuals, directives, aviation safety action messages, and airworthiness releases. Properly classifies and stores MSDS and inspects inventories of petroleum products for use of everyday aircraft maintenance. Mechanic should have an understanding of U.S. Government Unit Card Holder and GFEBs Operations process, Army Oil Analysis Program (AOAP) functionality, and understanding of HAZMAT operations; incumbent Supervises aircraft maintenance and GFE operations for the unit. Incumbent manages parts and facility requirements to repair aircraft and associated equipment for our Singapore Air Force partners. Repairer assists with the planning of aircraft maintenance areas, and facilitates proper by the book aircraft repair and technical inspection techniques according to directives, technical manuals, work standards and operational policies. Maintains supply economy and discipline through 3 major TDY mission operations annually, and assists with the unit's technical training program. Prepares evaluations, special reports and records pertaining to aircraft maintenance repair and related activities; assists with administering plans and policies for drivers training for ground support vehicles.
