 2. DA Form 705 (APFT), within the last 12 months (ensure that height and weight are annotated)/legible DTMS printout acceptable for both PT test and height and weight. Profiles must be attached if applicable.
 3. Body Fat Worksheet (DA Form 5500-R) if applicable
 4. NGB Form 23, NGB Form 22b (RPAS Statement), retirement record (National Guard Only).
 5. Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS).
 6. Copy of ERB/ORB (whichever pertains to you)

 6. Must not be flagged in SIDPERS for weight, APFT, security violations or pending any adverse actions
 7. Must be able to pass the 3 event APFT
 8. Must meet the Army body fat standards IAW AR 600-9
 9. Permanent Change of Station (PCS) expenses are not authorized for this position.
 10. Valid AZ Driver's License
 11. Primary consideration will be given to 56M, 36F, 42A and related CMFs
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BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:
Serves as Strong Bonds Manpower Specialist/NCO at JFHQ-AZ, PPMR in Phoenix AZ. Responsible for assisting with Strong Bonds execution and tracking manpower of all personnel involved with execution of the Arizona Army National Guard Strong Bonds Program, statewide. Reports directly to JFHQ-AZ Full-Time Support Chaplain and provides regular reporting and accountability internally and roll-up reporting to National Guard Bureau Office of the Chaplain (NGB-OC) in support of successful and continued relationship training events and programming. Primary duties include data capture and analysis of man hours required to plan, prepare, execute, and report for Strong Bonds events. Additional duties include, but are not limited to, providing coordination and direct event logistical support across the state of Arizona. Additional related duties as assigned.
