 2. DA Form 705 (APFT), within the last 12 months (ensure that height and weight are annotated)/legible DTMS printout acceptable for both PT test and height and weight. Profiles must be attached if applicable.
 3. Proof of meeting body composition standards IAW AR 600-9 (within 6 months.) DTMS printout can be used. (DA Form 5500/5501, if applicable.)
 4. NGB Form 23B.
 5. Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS).

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BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Yellow Ribbon NCO/Post-Deployment Health Reassessment (PDHRA) Coordinator is tasked with supporting deployment readiness for the Arizona Army National Guard through direct support to pre-, mid-, and post-mobilization Yellow Ribbon and PDHRA events. These events are typically scheduled for off-drill weekends and the selectees will participate in these events in addition to regularly scheduled IDT weekends. Duties include: assisting Yellow Ribbon NCOIC in preparation of event schedules, preparing and maintaining event registration on the Joint Service Support website; preparing travel authorizations and vouchers for submission; coordinating event support and attendance with community partners; setting up Yellow Ribbon event equipment; preparing and managing event-related correspondence; other duties as assigned in support of the Yellow Ribbon program; scheduling and coordinating PDHRA events for redeployed Soldiers; and temporary details to other sections within the G-1 as organizational needs require.
