AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

This position is in the Federal/Excepted Civil Service and is **open to current members and those eligible for membership in the Arizona Air National Guard.** Individual selected will receive an **Indefinite Appointment** and may be converted to permanent based on availability of funds or position no longer being encumbered. Acceptance of a Federal Excepted technician position of over 179 days in length will cause termination from the Selected Reserve Incentive Program (BONUS). Individual selected will require a military medical records screening if applicable, to be completed prior to appointment, and/or may be required to take a pre-employment medical screening examination dependent on the position type and military medical records screening results.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: Individuals applying for vacancies with the Arizona National Guard may submit Optional Form 612 (Optional Application for Federal Employment), or a Resume. Application documents must contain the Announcement Number, Title and Grade(s) of the job being applied for. Personal information must include full name and address (including ZIP Code), Day and evening phone numbers (with area code). Work experience information should be limited to either paid or nonpaid experience directly related to the position that the individual is applying for and must include: Job Title, Duties and accomplishments, Employers name and address, Supervisors name and phone number, starting and ending dates, hours per week and salary.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED FOR SUCCESSFUL PERFORMANCE IN THIS POSITION:

1. Knowledge in functional and operational sustainment of data processing programs such as Integrated Base Defense Security Systems and Security Forces Information Management System.
2. Skill in writing or maintaining related data processing reports for command echelon personnel.
3. Skill in providing feedback to supervisor regarding identified or perceived base access vulnerabilities with recommendations for mitigations.
4. Ability to research, interpret, and/or analyze guidelines to ensure work complies with legal and regulatory requirements.
5. Ability to communicate effectively both written and orally.

SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE: Must possess at least 24 months of experience or training in advising supervisor of any base or site activities that may impact the Integrated Base Defense Security Systems program. Skilled in completing reports and documents the Intrusion Detection System program maintenance requirements to the servicing maintenance organization. Experienced in monitoring Intrusion Detection System false and nuisance alarms and knowledgeable on how to request assistance from the maintenance organization to resolve problems and deficiency. Experienced on coordinating with maintenance and materiel management functions to ensure sufficient spare parts and maintenance are

available to support the Integrated Base Defense Security Systems equipment and component. Capable of maintaining and using Technical Orders and commercial manuals that describe equipment components and operating procedures for Intrusion Detection System program. Experienced in assisting in the development of local training for system operators and in the standardization and evaluation section that develops certification standards for system operators. Competent in managing and administering the physical access control systems. Has the working knowledge of entry control points and related applications associated with the Integrated Base Defense Security Systems and the Security Forces Information Management System.

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION: This position is located at the 161st Air Refueling Wing, Phoenix, Arizona. The primary purpose of this position is to be responsible for all base electronic security systems by performing electronic security systems duties and managing all functions necessary to sustain electronic security protection in all areas of the installation. Additionally, in performing force protection duties to ensure combat capability through the functions of installation defense security, nuclear and conventional weapon systems, anti-terrorism identifications, trends, and analysis, resources security, intelligence gathering, military police functions, law enforcement protection, information protection security, and combat arms training and maintenance. Security Administration employees participate in contingency operations. Personnel in this career field are deployed and employed in sensitive or hostile environments created by terrorism, sabotage, nuclear, chemical, biological, or conventional warfare.
