AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

This position is in the Federal/Excepted Civil Service and is **open to current members in the Arizona Air National Guard.** Individual selected will receive a **Permanent Appointment** after successful completion of a one year trial period. Acceptance of a Federal Excepted technician position of over 179 days in length will cause termination from the Selected Reserve Incentive Program (BONUS). Individual selected will require a military medical records screening if applicable, to be completed prior to appointment, and/or may be required to take a pre-employment medical screening examination dependent on the position type and military medical records screening results.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: Individuals applying for vacancies with the Arizona National Guard may submit Optional Form 612 (Optional Application for Federal Employment), or a Resume. Application documents must contain the Announcement Number, Title and Grade(s) of the job being applied for. Personal information must include full name and address (including ZIP Code), Day and evening phone numbers (with area code). Work experience information should be limited to either paid or nonpaid experience directly related to the position that the individual is applying for and must include: Job Title, Duties and accomplishments, Employers name and address, Supervisors name and phone number, starting and ending dates, hours per week and salary.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED FOR SUCCESSFUL PERFORMANCE IN THIS POSITION:

SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE:

Experience planning the sequence of actions necessary to accomplish the assignment where this entailed coordination with others outside the organizational unit and development of project controls. Experience that required adaptations of guidelines or precedents to meet the needs of the assignment.

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION: This position is located at Davis Monthan AFB, AZ (Tucson, AZ) working in an Air

National Guard Maintenance Group supporting a Remotely Piloted Aircraft (RPA) mission. The purpose of the position is to provide maintenance support for the Ground Control Stations (GCS) and applicable support equipment used for the operation of RPA's. The incumbent provides maintenance and technical system support for GCS's, Ground Data Terminals (GDT), SATCOM Earth Terminal Subsystem (SETSS) and associated Support Equipment. The incumbent is responsible for installing, inspecting, troubleshooting and repair of these IT systems hardware and software.
