AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

This position is in the Federal/Excepted Civil Service and is **open to current members and those eligible for membership in the Arizona Army National Guard.** Individual selected will receive a **Permanent Appointment** after successful completion of a one year trial period. Acceptance of a Federal Excepted technician position of over 179 days in length will cause termination from the Selected Reserve Incentive Program (BONUS). Individual selected will require a military medical records screening if applicable, to be completed prior to appointment, and/or may be required to take a pre-employment medical screening examination dependent on the position type and military medical records screening results.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: Individuals applying for vacancies with the Arizona National Guard may submit Optional Form 612 (Optional Application for Federal Employment), or a Resume. Application documents must contain the Announcement Number, Title and Grade(s) of the job being applied for. Personal information must include full name and address (including ZIP Code), Day and evening phone numbers (with area code). Work experience information should be limited to either paid or nonpaid experience directly related to the position that the individual is applying for and must include: Job Title, Duties and accomplishments, Employers name and address, Supervisors name and phone number, starting and ending dates, hours per week and salary.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED FOR SUCCESSFUL PERFORMANCE IN THIS POSITION:

Each applicant should fully justify on their application how they meet each KSA listed below using AZNG Form 335-2-R to reference the justification.

1. Ability to inspects and tests Army Standard Integrated Target systems, using wiring diagrams, schematics, technical manuals and test equipment (i.e., voltmeters, multiplexers, miniature consoles and digital multi-meters). Visually examines systems and systems components to identify and troubleshoot causes of malfunctions.
2. Ability to isolates faulty components and determines extent of repair or replacement required to restore power, signal or correct mechanical operation. Repairs or replaces exposed, broken, cut or damaged cables. Removes, replaces and adjusts damaged or inoperable target system's components.
3. Ability to installs thermal target equipment to include, but not be limited to, AC or DC powered thermal heating panels. Tests and troubleshoots thermal target panels, using a digital multi-meter equipped with a thermal probe. Operates and maintains laser interface devices designed to be used in conjunction with existing target systems employed on ranges.
4. Ability to operates and performs operational and organizational maintenance on gasoline and/or diesel powered generating systems and various portable power sources used in support of range control and target systems.
5. Ability to prepares demolitions in conjunction with radio and/or computer controlled target system mechanisms.
6. Ability to operates and maintains equipment used for such purposes as berm repair and maintenance, grass cutting, snow removal, or otherwise maintaining the range area in order to keep ranges operational to the maximum extent possible on a year round basis.

SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE: Must possess at least **12** months demonstrating knowledge of electronics, test equipment, measuring devices, and equipment used to assemble, disassemble, clean, replace, or adjust target systems and control panels. Candidates must be proficient in reading and interpreting technical manuals, specifications, and wiring diagrams to aid in minor troubleshooting and repairs of defected equipment.

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION: This position is located at the AZTC, Florence, Arizona. The purpose of the position is to repair, install, operate, and maintain a variety of Army Standard Integrated Target Systems, such as Armor Moving Target Carriers (AMTC), Infantry Moving Target Carrier Systems (IMTS), Target Holding Mechanism Tank Gunnery (THMTG) and Enhanced Remote Target Systems (ERETS). Operates computer-controlled target system consoles and develops scenarios for operation. Operates and performs maintenance on power generating and portable power source equipment.

Arms, detonates, and/or disarms pyrotechnics and demolition devices. Fabricates and/or repairs metal, wood and cardboard targets. Operates and maintains vehicles assigned to the shop.
