BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Incumbent serves as an AH-64D Aircraft Mission Survivability Officer (AMSO) for the United States Army Flight Training Detachment (USAFTD), supporting the Republic of Singapore's Peace Vanguard program. Serves as the primary advisor and tactical/technical expert on Aviation mission survivability for the Detachment. Primary responsibilities include conducting aviation mission survivability analysis, Army Aviation survivability Electronic Warfare operational planning and Aviation Mission Planning System (AMPS) management. Functions as a direct training participant by piloting aircraft under tactical and non-tactical conditions, while supporting full spectrum training missions and operations to include live fire combat missions in all types of environmental situations. Participates in joint mission planning with Republic of Singapore Air Force (RSAF) counterparts for multiple training exercises and conducts after-action-reviews to improve quality of training. Incumbent will also provide support to the USAFTD operations section on threat capabilities and limitations which affect the ability to perform aviation missions for the program. Performs additional duty as an Aviation Life Support Equipment (ALSE) Officer, providing technical assistance and support to the Aviation Life Support System (ALSS). Incumbent will be expected to tailor communication and interpersonal skills when coordinating with the RSAF for unit operations in a complex foreign military sales environment. Graduate of the Aviation Mission Survivability (AMS) Officer Course preferred.
