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BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Responsible for serving as the H2F Project Officer for the AZARNG Soldier Support Division specifically focused on the domains of Physical Fitness and Performance, Nutritional and Dietary Support, and Sleep Wellness, and providing support to integrating these efforts with the other H2F pillars. Understand Holistic Health and Fitness (H2F) IAW FM 7-22 and ATP 7-22.01. Be prepared to lead implementation of the H2F System within AZARNG IOT improve Soldier performance across all 5 H2F Domains in an effort to increase readiness across the force. Support AZARNG units with planning, and assessing implementation of the approved ACFT as needed. Serve as the point of contact to the BDEs and DRUs regarding ACFT/H2F guidance. Prepares products and briefing materials for state leadership on H2F and provides monthly updates to National Guard Bureau. Collaborate with G1, G3, MEDDET, State Chaplain, PAO and multiple civilian resource providers to implement all 5 H2F Domains into AZARNG Operations. Project officers are expected to network and communicate with other Project Officers within Region 7 (AZ, CA, CO, GU, HI, NM, NV, UT). Other duties as assigned.
