TRADITIONAL GUARD STAFF JUDGE ADVOCATE VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

The 162d Legal Office, Tucson, Arizona, is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Staff Judge Advocate (O-4/Maj – O-5/Lt Col). This position is in the traditional DSG Guardsman and is open to current members and those eligible for membership in the Arizona Air National Guard. In order to be considered for this position applicants must meet minimum qualifications.

Application deadline: Open until position is filled

Minimum Skill/Experience requirements:

- MUST possess AFSC 51J3
- MUST be able to obtain a Top-Secret Clearance
- MUST have a Bachelor of Laws or Juris Doctor degree in law issued by an ABA-accredited law school; and, must be admitted to practice law in the State of Arizona or the highest court of any U.S. state, commonwealth, territory or the District of Columbia and be able to waive into the Arizona Bar.
- MUST complete accession package for JAG Corps

Training requirements:

- To be discussed prior to appointment

Application package should include the following:

- Submit the following documents to the 162d Legal Office, by email to rudypadilla@us.af.mil no later than application deadline. Applications should include the following:
 1. AF Form 24, Application for Appointment as a Reserve of the Air Force.
 2. AF Form 2030, USAF Drug and Alcohol Abuse Certificate
 3. One personal statement
 4. Detailed Resume, Military Bio (If Applicable)
 5. All OPRs
 6. All DD 214 Forms
 7. AF Form 469 (If Applicable)
 8. Current Report of Individual Personnel (RIP). RIP can be obtained from the servicing Military Personnel Flight (MPF). In lieu of a RIP, applicant may provide a printout from the Virtual MPF (vMPF). Select 'Record Review' and then 'Print/View All Pages'

9. All transcripts w/ Registrar signature (NOT REQUIRED for separating RegAF or ARC judge advocates)
10. Certificate of good standing from highest court of a state, territory, or DC (needs to be dated within 1 year of application)
