AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of: E3-E5. Individual selected will receive an FTNGD-OS Tour with the Arizona Army National Guard. Individual(s) selected will receive an FTNGD-OS Tour with the Arizona Army National Guard through 30 September 2023. In order to be considered for this position applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined within this announcement.

NOTE: Selection for this position requires eligibility IAW PPOM 20-003, Policy for Army National Guard (ARNG) Members Performing Full-Time National Guard Duty for Operational Support (FTNGD-OS) other than Active Guard and Reserve (AGR) Duty/Counter Drug (CD).

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: The documents listed WILL be submitted "AS A MINIMUM". If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position. Applications must be submitted following the instructions on this announcement. Applications are accepted through FTSMCS, please see FTSMCS INSTRUCTIONS located on DEMA website. If updates are needed it can be done at your nearest DEERS/RAPIDS Office. Incomplete applications will not be processed

2. Copy of ORB/ERB
3. last 3 NCOER's if applicable
4. Provide copy of NGB Form 23B
5. Provide copy of Individual Medical Readiness Record (MEDPROS). PHA must have been completed within 15 months.
6. Passing body fat standard within 6 months – Within COVID19 Guidelines (DTMS print out and/or DA Form 5500-R if applicable.)
7. Copy of most recent ACFT (DA Form 705-TEST). Profiles must be attached, if applicable.

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Duty requirements include but not limited to receiving, inspecting, loading, segregating, and the accountability of supplies that vary from uniforms to sensitive items. This includes operating unit-level computers, making dorm keys, and preparing rosters for students residing at the schoolhouse. MOS qualified 92Y are also responsible for preparing all unit and organizational supply documents. Maintaining automated supply system for accounting of organizational and installation supplies and equipment. Coordinating supply activities. Posting transactions to organizational and installation property books and supporting transaction files using the Army Records Information Management Systems (ARIMS). Unit supply specialists learn the procedures for shipping, receiving, storing and issuing stock, as well as stock control and accounting procedures. They will manage the handling, movement, storage, and maintenance of ammunition, medical and food supplies. Performs other duties as assigned.
