**\*\*Applicants who currently possess a military grade one grade level higher than above posted grade level may be considered for this vacancy. If an over graded applicant is selected they must be reduced in grade prior to being accessed into this position. Applying for and accepting a lower graded military position is considered a voluntary reduction in grade. IAW ANGI 36-2503, an applicant must submit in writing their willingness to be administratively reduced in grade and submit this letter with their application package.\*\***

**AREA OF CONSIDERATION:** Statewide. Must be a current member of the AZ National Guard within the grade(s) of E4 and E5.

Individual selected will receive Active Duty Title 32 Tour with the Arizona Air National Guard. In order to be considered for this position applicants must meet minimum qualifications.

1. **\*REQUIRED\*** Completed NGB 34-1
  2. **\*REQUIRED\*** Detailed Resume with dates of employment (military and civilian) and contact information.
  3. **\*REQUIRED\*** vMPF RIP. Data Verification Brief or Career Data Briefs will not be accepted. All information to qualify you for an AGR position must be present within your RIP. Enlisted Members **MUST** show ASVAB scores. If there is a system limitation causing your record to be incorrect, you must include the official supporting source document with your package.
  4. **\*\*REQUIRED\*\*** MyFitness Individual Fitness Tracker from MyFitness via myFSS showing current results and history (**MUST** be within 12 months). No other documents will fulfill this requirement. Member must be current/passing within fitness standards IAW AFI 36-2905. AF 469 **MUST** be provided for exemptions on most recent fitness assessment.
  5. **\*REQUIRED\*** AF Form 422, Physical Profile Serial Report and DD Form 2992 (flight status only). Must be current within 12 months, this form can be obtained from your Wing Clinic.
  6. AZNG 335-1-R / Military Brief
  7. AZ Form 34-1, Arizona AGR Application Supplement
  8. Letter of verification of Security Clearance from local Security Manager.
  9. Memorandum in Lieu of any missing or flawed required documents.

**POSITION COMPATIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

**The individual(s) must be a member of the Arizona AIR National Guard and qualify for and be placed in the following compatible AFSC/AOC prior to starting AGR tour: 2W0X**

**MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Must possess AFSC 2W051.
  2. Must be in the rank of SrA/E4- SSgt/E5
  3. This position is subject to rotating shifts, weekends, TDYs and holidays.

**ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Must be in compliance with physical fitness, height, weight, and body fat measurement standards as listed in AFI 36-2905.
2. If selected member is pregnant, orders may commence as long the member can safely perform duties within the restrictions of the AF 469 and with chain of command approval.
3. If required, we will initiate an investigation for a security clearance. Unfavorable results will be cause for your immediate separation.
4. Individuals who cannot obtain 20 years of Active Federal Service prior to reaching mandatory retirement, age 60 for enlisted personnel, or mandatory separation date for officers, if selected you must submit a Waiver for Exceptional Circumstances to their HRO remote, through the HRO with final approval at the Air Component Commander level. Waivers must justify why it is in the best interest of the unit, State, or Air National Guard.
5. You must meet eligibility requirements of AFI36-2101 Classifying Military Personnel (Officer and Enlisted) and ANGI 36-101 (The Active Guard/Reserve Program).
6. Individuals selected for Control Grade positions are subject to Control Grade availability.

**EVALUATION PROCESS:** Each applicant must **FULLY SUBSTANTIATE** on their application how they meet the requirements for the position being advertised; otherwise applicant will be considered unqualified for this position. Applications will be evaluated solely on information supplied in the application (NGB Form 34-1) or resume. Experience will be evaluated based on relevance to the position for which application is being made. Include job titles, starting and ending dates (month and year), hours per week, salary, duties/accomplishments, employer(s) name and address, and supervisor(s) name/phone number and permission to contact.

**BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:**

This position is located at the 162nd Wing, Maintenance Squadron, Morris ANG, Tucson, Arizona. The purpose of this position is to perform maintenance on assigned missiles, operate missile test equipment, operate the Theater Integrated Combat Munitions System (TICMS), store, handle and perform intermediate level maintenance on assigned conventional munitions. Conducts operational tests using special purpose test equipment and precision measurement devices. Analyzes varying forms of data from different sources of test equipment and isolates system component malfunctions by visual observation or use of electronic, pneumatic, and pneudraulic test equipment. Interprets wiring diagrams, evaluates, and analyzes equipment specifications and other technical documents. Disassembles missiles and determines the nature and extent of component and parts repair required. Receives assembles, issues, identifies, inspects, and stores conventional aerospace munitions such as bombs, ammunition, starter cartridges, flares, egress munitions, etc. Operates Theater Integrated Combat Munitions System (TICMS) in accordance with applicable regulations and manuals. Inspects, maintains, repairs, and reconditions conventional munitions, containers, and munitions maintenance handling equipment (MMHE). Links and repositions ammunition by operating electrical or manual machines and inspecting for defects such as short or long rounds, corrosion, and dented cases, and removes unserviceable rounds.
