AREA OF CONSIDERATION:

This position is in the Federal/Excepted Civil Service and is **open to current members and those eligible for membership in the Arizona Air National Guard.** Individual selected will receive an **Indefinite Appointment** and may be converted to permanent based on availability of funds or position no longer being encumbered. Acceptance of a Federal Excepted technician position of over 179 days in length will cause termination from the Selected Reserve Incentive Program (BONUS). Individual selected will require a military medical records screening if applicable, to be completed prior to appointment, and/or may be required to take a pre-employment medical screening examination dependent on the position type and military medical records screening results.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: Individuals applying for vacancies with the Arizona National Guard may submit Optional Form 612 (Optional Application for Federal Employment), or a Resume. Application documents must contain the Announcement Number, Title and Grade(s) of the job being applied for. KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED FOR SUCCESSFUL PERFORMANCE IN THIS POSITION:

1. Knowledge of electronic theories and practices of integrated electronic, pneumatic, hydraulic, radiological, optical and mechanical systems of such applications as digital or analog computers, digital display devices which enables the incumbent to understand and predict the effects of subsystem malfunctions on the total function system.
2. Ability to isolate malfunctions of complete multiple integrated system complexes consisting of closely interrelated integrated and non-integrated systems as well as demonstrating the ability to interpret technical manuals, specifications and publications.
3. Ability to apply electronic theories and practices to identify, isolate and repair malfunctions in one or more complex integrated systems where knowledge of the entire system is necessary to interpret error data and trace problems back through a number of units of the system to locate deficiencies.
4. Knowledge of the technology and practices which integrate the component of the systems into the total functional system.
5. Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.

SPECIALIZED EXPERIENCE: Must have at least a three-skill level in one of the compatible AFSCs, with 12 months of work experience or compatible aircraft maintenance/armament/munitions craftsman (or seven skill level) PAFSC, and required ASVAB scores required by FWS 2610 Series. Experiences involved duties such as, inspecting, testing,

troubleshooting, repairing and modifying software controlled automated and manually controlled test stations/equipment, electronic circuits, peripherals, support equipment and associated subsystems. Knowledgeable of test stations/equipment that are used to repair and maintain all avionics line-replaceable units and support equipment. Skilled in analyzing performance, running tests, conducting inspections, troubleshooting, identifying and isolating malfunctions, disassembling, modifying or repairing and reassembling the test stations or electronic circuits and their associated peripherals. Skilled in reading the complex inter-related variables that resulted from a mix of computer hardware and software, stimulus and measurement systems, and special purpose test subsystems. Experiences involved analyzing malfunctions using schematics, logic and wiring diagrams, programming tables, computer program flow charts, software user guides, computer program listings and factory drawings.

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION: This position is located at the 162d Wing in Tucson, AZ in either the Avionics Intermediate Shop (AIS), Improved Avionics Intermediate Shop (IAIS) or ECM Pod Shop, Component Repair Branch, of an Aircraft Maintenance Squadron. This is an Air National Guard (ANG) Dual Status Technician position requiring military membership, compatible military skill assignment, and classification. The primary purpose of this position is to inspect, test, troubleshoot, repair and modify software controlled automated and manually controlled test stations/test equipment, ECM Pods, peripherals, support equipment and associated subsystems. The test stations/test equipment are used to repair and maintain all avionics line-replaceable units (LRUs) and Pods. In addition this position installs serviceable components, repairs faulty wiring as required, recommends hardware and software changes, submits change recommendations to technical orders, requisitions supply assets, processes repairable assets in accordance with standard base supply system requirements, documents maintenance actions and man-hour expenditures in the proper management information system, provides training to any personnel concerned with repair of integrated avionics systems, prepares for and participates in AEF taskings, deployments and various inspections as well as exercises, complies with safety, fire, security, and housekeeping regulations, ensures that material and equipment are properly stored, protected and maintained. This position may also be required to perform additional duties such as launch and recovery, aircraft servicing, firefighting, aircraft crash and rescue duty and or serve as a member of a natural disasters civil emergencies team.
