ENTRY GUIDELINES



There is no entry fee for the contest.



Anyone may apply to the contest, but minors must obtain parental permission.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

All entries must be submitted electronically via a website entry form at <u>dema.az.gov/licenseplatecontes</u>t (a digital picture of the design is acceptable). The maximum file size is 100 MB in JPG format.

All submissions are due by March 29, 2024. One person may enter more than one submission with a maximum of four.

The winning entry may be incorporated into an official license plate by the Arizona Department of Transportation or used by other Arizona state agencies without credit, authorship, or other name recognition of the winning contetestant.
